

The country's accession to the Eurasian Union eased the situation of migrants

Edition Headings Regions Photo Dmitry Lokaj Kommersant The Treaty of accession of Kyrgyzstan to the Eurasian economic Union came into force, now the citizens of this country do not need work the patent for work in Russia. Interviewed by Kommersant experts believe that the flow of labor migrants will not increase as it is limited to the proposals employers. Growth of competition for jobs between citizens of Russia and Kyrgyzstan also not expected. The Treaty of accession of Kyrgyzstan to the Eurasian economic Union which was signed on may 8 in Moscow the presidents of Russia Belarus Kazakhstan Armenia and Kyrgyzstan entered into force on 12 August. Now the citizens of Kyrgyzstan do not need a patent to work in Russia and the period of their temporary stay will be determined by the duration of the employment or civil-law contract concluded with the employer according to the Federal migration service FMS. Also, Kyrgyz labor migrants exempt from the procedure of recognition of documents on education. Now Kyrgyz citizens are free job seekers on the Eurasian labour market, reports the Agency. In Russia there are about 500 thousand labor migrants from Kyrgyzstan, this country shares the third and fourth places with Tajikistan the number of citizens working in Russia. First and second places are occupied by Uzbekistan and Ukraine told Kommersant that the head of the public organization Country without racism and xenophobia member of the Public chamber of the Russian Federation the Term Bakhrom Ismailov. According to him mainly Kyrgyz working in the field of domestic service in the restaurant business and in the housing sector. The area in which they are involved is not popular among the citizens of the Russian Federation operating in the areas with higher value added in high-tech industries, where higher education is required. In this regard, the Kyrgyz labor migrants do not compete with citizens of the Russian Federation said the expert. The majority of migrants from Kyrgyzstan according to the FMS in Moscow and Moscow region. Agree with him the head of the Public chamber Commission on development of public diplomacy and support of compatriots abroad Elena sutormina but she noted that the labour migrants from Kyrgyzstan work in higher positions if the level of education allows them. This is especially true of residents of the Northern regions of Kazakhstan where it is traditionally well speak Russian language, and developed his system of teaching. Moreover, thanks to the Federal target program Russian language which will operate from 2016 to 2020 in the country will increase the number of language centres improved the quality of teaching of the Russian language. Now there is a shortage of textbooks of the Russian language but
